



Backfill Explained

Backfill is what we use to fill in the recessed areas of your medallion. Each medallion is painted with our blue slip/stain which helps bring out all the fine details of the design. As a result, you will see mixing with the base glaze in the recessed areas of each medallion. Some base glazes show more of this mixing than others. Here are a few examples of what it could look like with different base glazes...

With glazes that show more of the mixing colors, we may suggest a fill color option. This is an extra contrasting color glaze that will fill in the medallion. Here are a couple examples of what this looks like...
